



# BUS CAPACITY

Bus transportation is provided within the ASD boundaries for schools with at least 60 students attending the same performance.

AJT will only provide busing when a minimum of 75% of busing capacity limits are reached. This means that if you have 85 students from your school attending, only one bus will be provided. In order to qualify for two buses, the number of paid seats would need to be at least 120. If you have less than the minimum required for a bus, we will research the availability of sharing a bus with another school in your area. Bus sharing occurs when there is overflow from one bus or to fill a bus so that your class can attend. We try to review this periodically prior to the show and will email you to see if you have another class that might join you to fill the bus (when space in the show is available) so sharing is not required.

## Busing capacity **Maximums:**

K - 2nd Grades	82 seats
3rd - 5th Grades	68 seats
6th - 12th Grades	56 seats
Wheelchair bus	52 seats

*Example 1: Mrs. Jones registers to see Click, Clack, Moo and has 30 students in her 1st Grade class. At the time of registration, she notes that she will be attending with Mr. Johnson. When show time arrives, it is discovered that Mr. Johnson never registered and decided not to attend. Busing would only be provided if we had another school to SHARE a bus.*

*Example 2: Four teachers from elementary school A register to see Harriet Tubman and their total number of seats for their 5th grade classes is 132. They would receive two buses.*

*Example 3: Five teachers from elementary school B register to see The History of Zydeco and their total number of seats for their 3rd grade classes is 160. Per busing capacity, two buses will be provided with an 'overflow' of 24 seats. If these students do not fit on the buses provided, they would need to ride with chaperones. If chaperones drive themselves, this will help the students fit on the bus. If requested, we will research to see if SHARING is an option (depends on availability).*
